The Symposium covers all aspects of the development of MMS from antiquity to the present and its historiography:

- Modern reviews of past works.
- People, history, and their works.
- Direct memories of the recent past.
- Historic development of theories.
- History of the design of machines and mechanisms.
- Developments of mechanical design and automation.
- The historic development of teaching, of schools of engineering and the education of engineers.

At HMM 2021 special attention will be given to the work and research of past distinguished members and the role of European and Iberoamerican experiences and designs in MMS.

Paper Submission

Full papers should be submitted through the web system to be indicated on the website. At least one registration is required per submitted paper.

Guidelines for the layout of the full papers will be available in the symposium website with Springer format.

Accepted papers will be published in the proceedings by Springer, in a volume of the series on the History of Mechanism and Machine Science http://www.springer.com/series/7481

There will be three awards (gold, silver and bronze) for each category: Student Paper, History Paper and Machine Reconstruction Paper. Gold awards will get a Springer voucher.

Location

HMM2022 will be held at Granada and Jaén, in southeast Spain.

Granada is located at the foot of the Sierra Nevada mountains and close to the Mediterranean Sea. The Alhambra complex is the world most spectacular Arab citadel and the symbol of Granada. It includes several areas that can be visited: Alcazaba, Palace of Charles V, Generalife and Nasrid Palaces.

Jaén will fascinate you due to its cultural mix as it has traditionally been a passing and frontier place; its lands have been inhabited by different millennial cultures, who lived here in harmony for centuries. Its history dates back to prehistoric times, with an economy originally rooted in the agriculture around the olive tree which makes Jaén the world capital of olive oil. Sites of interest such as the Cathedral or the Arab Baths are a must in the city.

The organization will agree on special rates with several hotels in Granada located near the venue of the symposium. More information will be available on the website.
